In 21 years, 567 youth have volunteered over 11,000 hours to help our community

"Special Tuesday"

The first 4 Tuesdays of every summer is spent giving to the special needs individuals of our community. We meet at Gonzales Primary for an awesome day of food, games, and fun. The last Tuesday of our summer fun



ends with a very special "Mardi Gras" parade for Our participants.

Special Tuesday is a program that was created almost 30 years ago by founder, Bobbie Blanchard. The program, officially named the "Beau Porta Special Tuesday" is in honor of Ms. Blanchard's late grandson. Special Tuesday is very near and dear to our hearts at Volunteer Ascension. Due to deep love for this program, in 2017 the Volunteer Board of Directors unanimously voted to adopt Special Tuesday. It is our goal to continue to seek and retain funding to continue to offer this valued program in our community.

"School Tools"

Our School Tools Program has celebrated 25 years of continued success in providing school supplies to children in need. Through collaboration with the Ascension Parish School Board, and with the help of many motivated volunteers, we were again able to identify and aid children entering Kindergarten-8th Grade. With the help of Ascension Parish teachers, counselors and administration, the program has evolved into a highly efficient, "well-oiled machine". Each year in July we set aside a weekend to collect school supplies from residents and local businesses. The supplies are counted, sorted, and packed, labeled and ready for "pick-up" by representatives from each school. The incredible amount of teamwork required for this task does not go unnoticed. Each year we are amazed at the number of volunteers that come and do whatever it takes to ensure that the last truck or SUV drives away with exactly what is needed for each Ascension Parish child to begin their school year.

School Uniforms

For the 21st year, Volunteer Ascension provided Ascension Parish students in need with school uniforms. By working directly with the guidance counselors, we can address the specific uniform needs at each school. In most cases, uniform requests are filled within the same day! We are dedicated to making sure that every child has the supplies they need to be successful at school.

<u>Disaster Relief</u>

In addition to our programs and events, we also partner with the Ascension Parish Office of Homeland Security and we play an integral part in the parish's Emergency Operations Plan.

- Activated during disaster and occupies a seat in Ascension Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness (OHSEP)
- Reporting Member of the Ascension Parish Unified Command Group (UCG) during disaster / emergency
- Coordinate incoming volunteer groups and resources
- Provide financial and material donations management
- Provide commodity distribution and coordinating faith-based resources and volunteers
- Responsible for staffing the Volunteer Reception Center at Lamar Dixon during post-disaster activation
- Co-Founders of the Ascension Strong Long-Term Recovery Group (established after 2016 Flood to connect residents with disaster resources)
- Coordinate parish-wide disaster supply drives at Lamar Dixon
